UPDATE: PROJECT ON FORESIGHT AND DEMOCRACY The research phase of the Project on Foresight and Democracy is completed. The final report to the Rockefeller Brothers Fund is being prepared, with the goal of submitting in December 2019. Thereafter, the co- directors will be ready to present findings to the FFCOI. The overall findings indicate that the systematic use of foresight promotes awareness of complexity in discourse about issues impacting the public, in ways that can strengthen the democratic process. The method lends itself to scaling up to global and down to local issues, and would do best if pursued on a sustained rather than an episodic basis. (POCs: [Sheila R. Ronis](#) and [Leon S.
