WOVEN CITY: Toyota is building a 175-acre hydrogen-powered test city at the base of Mount Fuji in Japan. This project, "Woven City," will be a fully connected ecosystem where approximately 2,000 residents and researchers will test and develop technologies, such as autonomous vehicles, robotics, and smart homes. This "living laboratory" will be the first of its kind, built from the ground up using an infrastructure of the future to support a real-life, multi-generational community.
